

This SketchUp training course teaches you how to model a home from scratch using this popular 3D modeling program. This course is designed for the absolute beginner, meaning no prior experience with SketchUP or 3D modeling is required.

You will start by learning the basics of the drawing tools, and then quickly jump into learning to create different roof types. This course will show you how to organize the model, including creating the second floor and additional openings, using the outliner, and viewing layer states of the model.

This course will show you how to create the different parts of a home, including the ceiling, staircase, doors and windows, fireplace, and kitchen. You will learn how to add furniture using the 3D warehouse and model the furniture from a photograph. You will then move to creating the exterior of the home, from setting the building in place to adding solar panels.

Finally, Ms Kanwal will show you various exporting options and how to create a rendering and animation.

By the completion of this computer based training course, you will be comfortable using many of the basic and complex tools in SketchUp.



As this is a concentration course, it would be helpful, though not required that students have a knowledge of the elements and principles of design.



- Apply textures and materials to your model (e.g. custom flooring textures)
- Space plan a kitchen, bathroom and joinery (millwork)
- Add dimensions and export your floor plan in PDF

- Turn the 2D floor plan in to a 3D home by creating walls, doors, windows, skirting and architraves (moulding)
- Add more custom textures to bring your model to life
- Add a ceiling to your model






Joinery (millwork) design

- Design custom joinery (millwork) from scratch e.g. kitchen, laundry and mudroom
- Create custom door profiles for your kitchens and joinery (millwork)
- Create your own custom knobs, fixtures and handles





Rendering with Vray, Furniture and Styling

Level: Expert

Furniture and styling using Vray plug in

- Finish the bathroom designs
- Place fixtures and fittings at the correct heights
- Apply custom wall paper and window dressings
- Add furniture, accessories, artwork and other finishing touches
- Project Yearning including (Layout, Furnishings, rendering etc)
